

Our Mission

Let It Be Us a 501 (c)(3) nonprofit organization, inspiring foster care and adoption in Illinois. As a licensed Illinois Child Welfare Agency, we recruit foster and adoptive parents and match them with Illinois children waiting for a family. Let It Be Us uses best practices in digital marketing and recruiting to reach more people to attract them to the world of foster care.

There are not enough licensed foster homes in Illinois, so children in the foster care system are sent to group homes, shelters, and hospital psychiatric wards. We aim to change this trajectory!

Program Impact


OUTREACH

Program Mission: Educate and recruit new foster parents from across Illinois. We hosted 20 Heart Gallery webinars from March - December.

LICENSING COACHING

Program Mission: Guide clients through the licensing process, and aim to push prospective foster parents through to get a license.

Outcomes: 223 parents coached, 82 parents in the process of getting licensed, and 66 parents licensed.



CHILD PLACEMENT SUPPORT

Program Mission: Help DCFS caseworkers and investigators quickly connect with licensed homes that are a good match for the children who need a home.

Outcomes: 248 children helped in 171 cases with 365 potential foster homes referred to agencies so children are placed with a foster home that fits their needs.

DIRECT SUPPORT FOR CHILDREN IN CARE

Program Mission: Provide financial and/or other types of support directly to children in care with an emphasis on filling needs that no other organization or entity is fulfilling. We aim for maximum impact on children in care

Chromebooks: \$20,625 Mentee support: \$13,230 Foster Family support: \$2,235


500 quality holiday gifts were given to the most needy children in foster care through the generosity of members and staff of the Hawthorn Woods Country Club.

Success Stories

On a cold winter's night, a caseworker reached out to **Let It Be Us** to help find a home for an **8 year old girl** who was destined for a shelter. Our search included towns one hour around the specific town where the caseworker and girl were sitting in the caseworker's office. Within two hours, we found two appropriate homes for the girl, and she was spared from having to go to the shelter.

Let It Be Us worked with two parents, a current high school teacher and a retired high school teacher. They had raised 3 girls, now all grown and on their own. Their goal was to foster a girl struggling in high school. A caseworker asked for help with a girl, let's call her Mary, who was struggling in school and suffering because of the stress that school was causing her. This family welcomed Mary with open arms and worked over the summer to help her get caught up and ready to start a new chapter in her life.
